Dr. Courtney Horvath is the Head of Strategy and Operations for Translational Medicine at Novartis and a TEDx speaker. Courtney graduated from the National Ballet School of Canada and after dancing professionally, she enrolled in Regis College, where she graduated as the valedictorian in 2006 with a major in biology and minor in chemistry. Courtney went on to complete her PhD and postdoctoral training at Dartmouth College, where her research garnered attention from the scientific community and the mainstream media. Courtney started her career in biopharma at Sanofi-Genzyme as a board-certified toxicologist and later moved to Novartis, where she is now a key leader of strategic projects. She has been recognized with numerous international awards. Courtney is also the mother of a pediatric cancer survivor, which has inspired her to become a passionate advocate for childhood cancer patients.

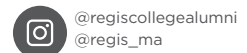
