Join us on a specially priced package tour to Greece featuring four nights in Athens and a four-night Greek Isles cruise on a Celestyal Cruises' cruise ship. The package includes sightseeing to the most beautiful and famous attractions in Greece, as well as most meals. Whether in a remote mountain village, at a coastal fishing community, or in Constitution Square in the very heart of Athens, all are welcomed by the warm-hearted Greek people! One soon realizes that even the most reserved Greeks are willing to share the experience that is Greece- classic ancient ruins, bordered by secluded beaches, dotted by picturesque ports, and highlighted by white-washed villages perched atop impressive mountains!!

### **OUR ITINERARY TO GREECE IS AS FOLLOWS:**

**DAY 1: BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~ATHENS:** Depart Boston's Logan Airport on our overnight flight to Athens (*via an intermediate city*). Dinner and breakfast will be served aloft. Headsets for our listening enjoyment will be provided. Beverage service is also available.

**DAY 2: ATHENS:** We will be transported from the airport in Athens to our first-class hotel, the Hotel Titania <a href="www.titania.gr">www.titania.gr</a> (or similar) for check-in with a bank stop en route. The remainder of the afternoon is at our leisure to freshen-up and relax prior to our orientation meeting and "welcoming drink" before dinner. (D)

**DAY 3: ATHENS:** Following breakfast at the hotel, we are off on a morning sightseeing tour of Athens, featuring many of the most important sites in this ancient capital: the Temple of Zeus, Hadrian's Arch, the Acropolis *(including the famous Parthenon and Temple of Athena)*, the Acropolis Museum and the Presidential Palace. The afternoon is free for shopping, relaxation or touring on our own. Dinner is included this evening. The rest of the evening is at our leisure to enjoy the lively atmosphere of the tavernas and night clubs! (B, D)

**DAY 4: DELPHI:** After breakfast we will board our motorcoach for our full-day tour to Delphi on the slopes of Mount Parnassus. Here, we will walk on the ancient sacred way to the Temple of Apollo and then, on to the Museum where we can see, among many other archaeological treasures, the unique bronze statue of the Charioteer! Next, we will visit the Athenian Treasury and Castalia Springs. Lunch will be in Delphi. Return to Athens for hotel check-in. Dinner this evening is included. (B, L, D)

**DAY 5: MYKONOS:** Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will board our motorcoach for the short drive to the port of Piraeus, where we will board our cruise ship. Depart Piraeus. Lunch onboard. Our first port-of-call is on the mountainous island of Mykonos, which is known for

its characteristic windmills and dazzling white-washed houses. Wander through the narrow, winding streets lined with trendy boutiques and friendly tavernas. Return to our ship for dinner (beverage package including non-premium drinks included!) and overnight. (B, L, D)

**CRUISE NOTE**: Shore excursions are not normally included, but we are pleased to have **two** included shore excursions in our package. The excursions are both on Day 6 with a tour to Ephesus during the Kusadasi visit, and on Patmos. Three additional shore excursions (to visit the Medieval Town and Palace of the Knights on Rhodes, the Minoan Palace on Crete, and a tour of Santorini) can be purchased in advance for \$299 per person. **Check off the appropriate box on your reservation form if you wish to reserve and pre-pay for the three additional shore excursions as part of your package.** 

**DAY 6: KUSADASI & PATMOS:** Breakfast onboard. Our first stop on today's agenda is in Kusadasi, Turkey, with an **included shore excursion** to visit the nearby Greek, Roman and Byzantine excavations of Ephesus. Our next port-of-call is on the island of Patmos (**shore excursion included**), where St. John the Divine is said to have written *The Revelation*. The 11<sup>th</sup> century monastery, known for its rare manuscript collection, is well worth a visit. Return to our ship for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 7: RHODES:** Breakfast onboard. Spend the entire day exploring the sun-drench island of Rhodes! Experience the historic Old City with its medieval ramparts and palaces built by the Knights of St. John during the crusades. As an alternative, Rhodes' spectacular beaches and colorful shopping district are within easy walking distance of the harbor. Return to our ship for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 8: HERAKLION (CRETE) & SANTORINI:** Breakfast onboard. Morning port-of-call on Crete, the Greek island made famous in Homer's epic poems. Heraklion, the capital of Crete and its principal commercial port, is just three miles away from the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. The Archaeological Museum in Heraklion displays many of the treasures found during the excavations. Afternoon visit to Santorini, the "Black Pearl of the Aegean" and possibly the most beautiful of all the Greek islands. Return to our ship for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 9: ATHENS~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON:** After breakfast, we will be transported to the airport where we will board our return flight to Boston (via an intermediate city) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in-flight. (B)

#### **OUR GREECE & GREEK ISLES CRUISE INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:**

- Round-trip motorcoach transportation to Boston's Logan Airport, free with a minimum 35 passengers. Additional charge if fewer. Minimum group size to qualify for bus transfer is 20 passengers.
- Special meet-and-greet service and assistance at Logan Airport by a Durgan Travel Representative.
- Round-trip regularly scheduled transatlantic flights Boston-Intermediate City-Athens and return with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight. The identity of the carrier, which may include the carrier's code-share partner, will be assigned and disclosed at a later date.
- Porterage of luggage at the hotel.
- All transfers and sightseeing aboard a deluxe, temperature-controlled, private motorcoach.
- 3 nights' accommodations at a first-class hotel in Athens and 4 nights aboard a Celestyal Cruise vessel as described in the itinerary, based on twin occupancy. Singles have a supplemental rate- see reservation form for details- and are subject to availability.
- Breakfast (B) and dinner daily (D), and one lunch while on the land portion. Wine included with dinners on the land portion. Three meals daily aboard the cruise. Cruise portion includes "BLUE" unlimited drink package (non-premium beverages).
- Comprehensive sightseeing package, as described in the itinerary, including entrance fees, where applicable.
- Professional Tour Escort, who will accompany our group throughout the tour, and expert English-speaking guides, as required.
- All meal and beverage taxes (for included meals).
